

4. The Committee considered the qualifications of teachers in the technical schools under the Board. The Ahsanullah School of Engineering being no longer under the Board, only the qualifications of teachers in the technical schools at Rajshahi, Pabna and Burdwan were considered. It was recommended that in every school there should be at least five teachers including the Superintendent. The qualifications and scales of pay should be as noted below.

1. Superintendent ... Graduate in Engineering with at least 5 years' practical experience, on grade Rs. 250/- 500/-,
2. Assistant Superintendent... Diploma in Engineering with at least 3 years' practical experience, on grade Rs. 150/- —250/-.
3. Teachers ... Best diploma holders after they have served in the departments for 3 years. On grade Rs. 120/- 250/-.
4. Artisan Instructors ... Best practical men are to be appointed.

The recommendations of the Committee have been forwarded to the Government of Bengal for consideration and necessary action.
